

Fedora 16 GRUB 2 File Not Found

If you have downloaded the Fedora 16 Alpha and pulled in the latest updates, you probably ended up with a *file not found* message instead of your GRUB2 menu when you rebooted. The offending package is *grub2-1.99-1.fc16.x86_64*.

The problem seems to be due the update removing GRUB2 *.mod* files.

If you have not yet rebooted your system after updating, simply run

```
grub2-install /dev/sda1
```

If your boot disk root partition is not */dev/sda1*, replace */dev/sda* with the correct device path for your root partition.

If you have rebooted and hit this problem, boot from a live CD in *rescue* mode, mount your root partition and run the *grub2-install* utility.

```
# mount -t ext4 -o rw /dev/sda1 /mnt
# grub2-install -boot-directory=/mnt/boot /dev/sda1
```

and reboot your system.
